I. Curricular Aspects

Academic Programmes

In this academic year 2019-2020, 3 new UG courses **BSW, BLIS and B.A. Tamil** have been introduced and totally there are 18 programmes at the UG Level and 11 Programme at the PG level. The Departments of Mathematics, Physics, Social Work, Management, English and Commerce offer M.Phil. Programme and the Departments of Biotechnology, Social Work, Management and Commerce offer Ph.D. Programme. Besides this the College also offers supplementary enrichment programmes such as 18 College Certificate and 9 university certificate programmes and 9 college Diploma courses and all IGNOU courses towards curriculum enrichment with academic flexibility.

IV. Infrastructure and Learning Resources

Infrastructure: With the constant support and patronage of our benevolent Management, the College continued the facilities towards quality education. A 250 KVA DG set has been bought to provide uninterrupted power supply.

Two multi-purpose halls have been built and inaugurated by **Very Rev.Mother Maria Philomi**, Mother General on 25th January, 2020. A separate lounge was also built for the drivers and Conductors and utilised with effect from 14th August, 2020.

In order to facilitate MBA programme, Bon Secours Institute of Management [BSIM] has been established with Administrative, instructional and other amenities as per AICTE regulations and inaugurated on 29th February, 2020 by **Rev. Mother Dr.Maria Philomi**. And also all the department have been furnished with additional furnitures.

Learning Resources:

Library

Our college has been functioning as Thanjavur District Study Centre for IGNOU since 2014. All IGNOU programmes are offered in the centre. 36 of our faculties are serving as Counsellors.

Transport

To cater for the needs of Rural Student Community, 3 more buses were added to the existing fleet of 33 buses.

V. Student Support and Progression

Student Support

The Institution concerns for Student support to promote optimal progression through Government Scholarship, Management Concession, Bons Children and Student Support Services such as SAFE, ICAN, MANNA, Earn While Learn Scheme and Endowments.

- **Government Scholarship**

The college familiarizes the students with all the scholarship schemes extended by the Government. The scholarships received during this year is **Rs.28,81,870/-**

- **Management Concession**

The Management as a part of its philanthropic activities extends scholarships to poor but deserving students every year. The alumnae of our college who pursue post graduate programmes are extended 10% concession in their tuition fees by the Management. The scholarship contributed by the Management for the year 2019-2020 is **Rs.10,02,400/-**.

- **Bons Children**

All the orphan students of the College are adopted by the Management. **13** such students were entrusted to the love, care and concern of the religious sisters of the community within the campus.

- **Earn While Learn**

Over and above the scholarships and other welfare schemes, the Management also sponsored the educational expenditure of **23 students** under this scheme. These students were given some jobs in the college store, library and laboratories so that they can earn while they learn.

- **Students Sponsored Welfare Programmes**

There are a few programmes regularly organized in the college by the students themselves. These programmes reflect the noble mind of the students. These programmes bear witness to the fact that Bon Secours College is keen on educating the minds of the students as well as their hearts.

1. **I Can**

‘I Can’ is the programme organized by the students themselves to help their own fellow students. The students organize fairs in the campus, and they are the sellers and buyers. The entire profit of the programme goes to the educational assistance of the underprivileged students. It is conducted in 2 phases, one in each semester. This year the first phase was conducted on 11th December, 2019 and the second phase on 12th February, 2020. The profit earned

this year through this programme is **Rs.5,23,258/-** and **220 students** have been assisted for their education from this amount.

2. SAFE – Students Assistance Fund for Education

SAFE is the charitable activity initiated by the Students Welfare Committee. Through this programme, the students collected donations within and outside the college.

3. Manna

It was observed by the Students Welfare Committee that the students who come from long distances go normally without their lunch. Therefore this programme was started to provide lunch for those students by collecting contribution from students and others. Now there are **55 students** who enjoy their lunch daily through this programme.
