I. Curricular Aspects

Academic Programmes

There are 18 programmes at the UG level and 10 Programmes at the PG level. The departments of Mathematics, Physics, English and Commerce and Management Studies offer M.Phil. Programmes and the departments of Biotechnology, Management and Commerce offer Ph.D. Programmes. Besides, the College also offers 7 University Diploma, 2 Certificate Courses, 105 Add - on Courses, and 58 value added courses a related to skill development, entrepreneurship etc.,

Curriculum Planning and Implementation

Faculty Course diary is the specially designed input facilitates continuous monitoring and evaluation of curriculum planning and delivery. Effective Curriculum delivery is realized through teacher preparedness and curriculum enrichment programmes such as special/guest lectures, trainings, seminars, conferences, workshops, outreach programmes, field visits and educational tours. Teaching Learning Process:

Teaching methodology imparts student-centered learning system through appropriate methodologies in respect of their background abilities and other personal attributes. Student Induction programme, Bridge Course were conducted for the new entrants at the very beginning of the academic year to introduce them the nuances of Know Thy Institution, language and communication, Research and Digital Quest. Especially designed inputs are provided to the students with learning difficulties through SALP (Slow and Advance Learners Programme), mentor system and GEM (Gear up Extraordinary Minds) and GUS (Gear up Self) programme through special lectures, trainings, seminars, conferences, workshops, outreach programmes, field visits and educational tours in line with enhancing learning experiences as participative, problem solving and experimental learning's. As the local chapter of SWAYAM NPTEL, faculties and students have enriched their knowledge through online courses.

Result Analysis:

The department level unit tests and weekly tests and college level two CIA examinations and pre-semester examinations were regularly conducted. We have produced 99% results in the University Examinations. Another highlight of the last year results is that the Under Graduate departments of English, BBA, History, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry Botany, Biotechnology, BCA, Information Technology, and Computer Science and Post Graduate departments of Social Work, Commerce, Commerce (CA), English, Biotechnology, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Computer Science and M.Phil. IV Infrastructure and Learning Resources:

Infrastructure: With the constant support and patronage of our benevolent Management, the College continued the facilities towards quality education. There were also necessary additions and improvements in the infrastructure facilities to cope with the growing demands. Renovation and extension works have been carried out in the Bon Cafeteria with improved amenities and was inaugurated on 14th August, 2020 with the blessings of Very Rev.Mother Lourdhu Mary, Ex. Mother General. An incubation centre-Iraivi Solution was established for promoting entrepreneurship and smart sanitary practices on 25th November, 2019. A 250 KVA DG set has been bought to provide uninterrupted power supply in 2020.

Two multi-purpose halls have been built and inaugurated by Very Rev.Mother Maria Philomi, Mother General on 25th January, 2020. A separate lounge was also built for the drivers and Conductors and utilized with effect from 14th August, 2020.To accommodate 150 audience at a time for Meeting, Seminar/Guest Lecture, Soft skill training. Departments can avail the hall based on the strength of the programme/ activities for curricular / co-curricular.

Library as Learning Resources:

Library is the store house of knowledge. It disseminates information and impart knowledge. It helps to develop the Language Skills like Listening, Speaking, Reading and Writing. It helps the research scholars to collect the resource materials for their research work. The college library is digitalized with access to unlimited e- resources. In this year 601 books were added to the library, 109 journals and magazines are available in the library. On 10.10.2020 KOHA software was installed.
