

'rocedure Followed

- The information is uploaded in the website and put up in the notice board.

 The mentors inform the students in the class about the scholarships facilities available to the students.
- The mentor collects the applications from the students and hands them over to the student welfare committee.

- The Principal makes the final selection in consultation with the student welfare committee.
