Report on the Online FDP - (18.05.2020 - 20.05.2020)


“Use Of Modern Technology In Promoting Learning During Covid-19”.

First Day Session - (18.02.2020) was addressed by Dr. P. Duvaraganathan, Assistant Professor, Department Of Humanities & Science, Rajalakshmi Engineering College, Thandalam, Chennai on the topic, **“Promoting Learning Among Staff Members.”** The speaker shared loads of information and guided the participants on the areas to be focused in order to update our skills and potentials. As the noble task of imparting quality education is in the hands of the teachers, he concluded his address by highlighting that the teachers should be like water in making the students community fertile & productive.

The second Day Session - (19.02.2020) started formally. Dr. S. Ganesan, Associate Professor, Department Of English, H.H.The Rajah’s College, Pudukkottai, was the resource person of the day.
